

CITY OF KWINANA PUBLIC NOTICE PROPOSED LOCAL LAW

Pursuant to section 3.12(3) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Kwinana gives notice that it intends to make the following new local law:

Waste Local Law 2021

Purpose - the purpose of the local law is to regulate the storage, collection and disposal of waste and refuse from premises and waste facilities in the City of Kwinana.

Effect - Unless otherwise authorised, the storage, collection and disposal of waste and refuse within the City must be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the local law. The effect of the proposed law is to:

1. enable the provision and administration of waste services, related matters and the raising of fees and charges;
2. enable the supply of receptacles for general waste, recycling and other types of waste;
3. make provision to impose on the owner or occupier of premises requirements, duties and conditions to facilitate the placement, collection and management of waste and receptacles;
4. enable the City to require owners or occupiers of premises to ensure that waste is removed from their premises;
5. require the owner or occupier of premises to place waste and waste receptacles in an appropriate manner to facilitate best practice recycling and/ or disposal of waste according to the terms and conditions of waste removal services provided by the City;
6. require the owner or occupier of premises to maintain and manage waste without creating a nuisance;
7. prohibit owners and occupiers of premises placing waste on verges outside of the scheduled times and conditions of the City's waste removal services;
8. enable the City and its authorised officers to issue directions to persons to comply with the provisions of the Waste Local Law;
9. determine whether a person who fails to act as directed by the City's authorised officers has committed an offence under the Waste Local Law; and
10. permit the City to issue notices and/or infringements for failure to comply with the Waste Local Law.
