

The City of Kwinana (City) has prepared a draft Local Planning Strategy (draft Strategy) which provides long-term planning directions and actions to guide the growth and development of the City over the next 10 -15 years.

In 2019, during an initial consultation phase, the community provided thoughts and ideas that helped to form the basis of the City of Kwinana's draft Local Planning Strategy. The City is again seeking the community's feedback on whether the draft Local Planning Strategy accurately reflects the communities vision for planning into the future.

In developing the draft Strategy, the City prepared a number of technical studies to forecast future population and requirements for housing, community facilities/services retail, and environmental protection.

The City also engaged the community to better understand the community's vision for the growth and development of Kwinana.



Feedback received by the City prior to preparing the draft Strategy indicated that public transport and the provision of a high quality integrated train and bus system is important to the community.

Kwinana's residents are dependent on private vehicles to travel to schools, shops, services, employment and recreation. An integrated transport network to distribute traffic and to provide linkages to other parts of the metropolitan region is crucial in facilitating access for the residents of Kwinana.

Access to regional roads and the freight rail network also provides opportunities for industries, businesses and the future Kwinana Outer Harbour to be well-connected to markets and suppliers.

The City aims to make it safer and more convenient for all residents to walk, cycle, use public transport and drive within Kwinana on an integrated network of paths, roads and public transport routes.

Key directions and actions of the draft Strategy are to create:

 A safe network of cycle routes and walking paths that are convenient for people of all ages and abilities to ride or walk to local destinations such as schools, shops, parks, bushland, bus stops and train

- stations. The draft Strategy will promote the continued roll out of the City's Bike and Walk Plan.
- An integrated transport network to distribute traffic within Kwinana and to provide linkages to other parts of the metropolitan region is crucial in facilitating regional access for the residents of Kwinana. The draft Strategy seeks to reinforce public transport usage with an action to advocate for the best bus services possible with links to the train stations.

In total the draft Strategy proposes over 70 actions to help shape the future planning of the City.

THE DRAFT STRATEGY IS A FIRST STEP IN THE ONGOING PROCESS OF REFINING AND DETAILING PLANNING WITHIN KWINANA. IT WILL BE REVIEWED AFTER FIVE YEARS AND ONGOING REFINEMENT WILL CONTINUE THROUGH THE LOCAL PLANNING SCHEME, STRATEGIES, POLICIES, STRUCTURE PLANNING, SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT.
