Arson	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) • Close working relationship with Emergency Services • Undertaking targeted bushfire mitigation in high-risk areas • Working closely with DFES and WA Police to respond to suspicious fires • Community education on bushfire prevention and reporting • CCTV Subsidy
Assault	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investigating personal safety devices • CPTED Approach – Street lighting across the City has been improved to improve visibility of streets • Walking groups are available to reduce individual feelings of safety. EOI available to start one in your area • Campaign on reporting to police – crime stoppers / eyes on the street • Public CCTV • The Zone is a safe space (Town Centre) • Trial Kickboxing / Self Defence Classes across the community
Careless and / or Dangerous Driving	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deploy traffic counters to monitor vehicle speeds in response to complaints on specific sections of local roads, with a focus on Quartermaine Boulevard • Share traffic data with WA Police for enforcement purposes at Quartermaine Boulevard and other locations as requested • “Remember 50 in BUA” signs were installed on Quartermaine Boulevard and Mokare Entrance • Assess and prune roadside vegetation where it restricts sight distance and contributes to road safety concerns, typically in response to customer requests (City Operations) • Ongoing infrastructure maintenance (footpath repairs, bollards)
Commercial Burglary	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CCTV Subsidy • Public CCTV • Working in collaboration with local businesses and Police in relation to reporting crime
Disorderly Behaviour	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trial Kickboxing / Self Defence Classes across the community • Activation of open spaces across the City through a number of avenues, including Healthy Lifestyle classes, as well as providing grants and funding for community events such as Neighbour Day • Walking groups are available to reduce individual feelings of safety. EOI available to start one in your area • Currently investigating communities understanding and experience of disorderly behaviour to possibly provide new initiatives to support community • Carry out an awareness campaign for community on reporting to Police
Drink / Drug Driving	6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working in collaboration with Police and community to encourage reporting to allow targeted responses from Police
Drug Dealing	7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Working in collaboration with Police and community to encourage reporting to allow targeted responses from Police • CPTED Approach – Street lighting across the City has been improved to improve visibility of the streets • Street by Street – a neighbourhood engagement initiative that brings residents together to educate and strengthen local connections, build community pride and encourage reporting to Police • Street Meets – build a connection with neighbours • Mobile CCTV Trailers to hotspot locations
Family Violence	8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community Services Working Group • Training City staff to understand the complexities and advocate for resources and support community
Graffiti	9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Education on reporting to Goodbye Graffiti and the City for rapid removal to support CPTED principles to discourage repeated graffiti • Opportunities for community to be involved in art murals across the City which help create a sense of ownership and pride • CCTV Subsidy • Mobile CCTV Trailers to hotspot locations
Home Burglary	10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) • CCTV Subsidy • Street Meets – build a connection with neighbours
