Hazardous Waste and Drop-off Points

Placing hazardous waste in your kerbside bin or on your verge at anytime can be dangerous!

Hazardous Waste includes:

Avoid fines by disposing of these items correctly.

- Batteries
- Electronic waste
- Fluorescent lights
- Fire extinguishers
- Gas cylinders
- Aerosols
- Paint and thinners
- Oil and chemicals
- Smoke detectors

Hazardous waste such as chemicals, batteries and aerosol cans cause truck fires. Help us avoid this by disposing of your waste correctly.



Your Waste Collection Day

Use the map to find your bin day.



Bin collection

Place out weekly



and

Place out on opposite fortnights



or

Still unsure? Use "My Bin Day" or call us on 9439 0200 kwinana.wa.gov.au/mybinday



Properties over 350m² automatically receive a Garden Organics (GO) bin. Smaller properties can opt-in.



Bin collections will be delayed by one day for Good Friday and Christmas Day public holidays

Your Bins

Waste sorting is easy! Here's a quick guide to help you use your bins correctly.

Bin collection enquiries

Call 1300 293 955



Place on kerb by 6am on collection day



Keep bin weight below 70kg



Ensure lid is fully closed



Return bins to your property as soon as possible



Collection times may vary. If you think your bin has been missed please call 1300 293 955



Hazardous Waste doesn't belong in your bins. Remember: Never bin a battery



E-waste also doesn't belong in your bin. Recycle it at a drop-off point or book a pre-booked verge collection

Place bins 1.5m from trees, cars and structures, at least 0.5m apart and within 1.5m of kerb



Didn't receive a GO bin?

If it grows in your garden, it goes in the GO bin



Pre-booked Verge Collections

Make the most of your waste

Before arranging your pre-booked verge collection, consider if your bulky items could be reused, repaired or recycled. One person's trash can be another's treasure!

Give Your Items a Second Life

Gift or Donate



Pass items on to family, friends, local charities or gift via your local Buy Nothing group.

Sell



Online marketplaces and garage sales are great ways to find new homes for unwanted goods.

Repair



A simple fix might bring an item back to life.

Recycle



Check drop-off points and recycling options for materials like metals, e-waste or bulky cardboard.
