Building our future together

The City is committed to meaningful community engagement to shape Kwinana's future. Through the 'Heading Towards One Hundred' campaign, 347 residents shared their aspirations, followed by 1,198 participants in the MARKYT Scorecards—94% rated Kwinana positively as a place to live. This feedback guided the Strategic Community Plan and aligned with key planning documents.

In the final engagement phase, the City shared a draft strategy shaped by community input. The Consultation Document received strong support, confirming our shared vision and ensuring community-led planning for a connected, prosperous Kwinana.
