Proposed Local Law

Pest Plants Local Law 2026

Pursuant to section 3.12(3) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the City of Kwinana gives local public notice that it intends to make the following new local law:

Pest Plants Local Law 2026

Purpose:

- To repeal the Town of Kwinana Pest Plants Local Law; and
- To enable the City of Kwinana to identify and control declared pest plants within the district that pose a threat to local biodiversity, agriculture or amenity.

Effect:

- To repeal the Town of Kwinana Pest Plants Local Law;
- To designate specific plants listed in Schedule 1 as pest plants throughout the district;
- To empower the City or an authorised person to serve notices on owners or occupiers requiring them to treat identified pest plants within a specified timeframe and in a specified manner;
- To allow the City to take remedial action at the expense of the owner or occupier if a notice is not complied with; and
- To establish offences and penalties for failure to comply with a notice.
