Zone Culture

The Zone Youth Space offers a friendly space for young people aged 12 to 18 years. To ensure all young people are able to enjoy their time at the Zone, please read and agree to the Zone culture:

1. Show respect to all people using the Zone, including the staff.
2. Help create equality by celebrating different genders, race, age, sexual orientation, etc.
3. Look after the building and equipment and ensure it's used appropriately. e.g. pool cues, games, computers, etc.
4. Keep your hands to yourself.
5. Stop, breathe, walk away, and seek staff assistance – instead of becoming verbally or physically aggressive.
6. Use appropriate language.
7. Respect others privacy by not videoing or photographing others without permission.
8. Keep everyone using the Zone safe by not bringing weapons, illegal or stolen items into the Zone. This includes drugs and alcohol.
9. Respect the health of others and yourself by not smoking or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs within the Zone or in close proximity to it (e.g. on the veranda and front steps of the Zone entry).

Duty of Care

The City of Kwinana's Zone Youth Space is a safe and friendly environment that is built on the values of leadership, equal opportunity and diversity by providing a range of services catering to the different needs and interests of its members. Staff at the Zone Youth Space don't have the authority to prevent young people from leaving the centre.

The City of Kwinana does not take any responsibility for young people who leave the Zone Youth Space and are no longer on the premises.

Behaviour and Consequences

Generally, misbehaviour (e.g. not complying with the Zone Culture) will be dealt with using a three-strike warning system, whereby on the third warning, the young person will be asked to leave the Zone Youth Space immediately. However, depending on the severity of the behaviour, staff may evict a young person without giving the three warnings. Again, depending on the severity of the behaviour, the City may ban a young person without giving the three warnings but not before giving them the right to respond to the proposed ban.

The Zone Youth Space is located on the corner of Gilmore Ave and Darius Drive, Kwinana (next to Kwinana Recquatic and opposite Calista Oval/Edge Skate Park).
