### Services for people

Individuals or families exposed to hardship from one or more risks, such as domestic or family violence, unstable housing circumstances or financial difficulties, are more vulnerable to experiencing homelessness and social exclusion. This can result in negative effects on a person's physical and mental health, education and employment opportunities.

Many people experiencing disadvantage have complex needs such as mental health and/or drug and alcohol issues. They may also have experienced traumatic life events that affect their needs and these issues may result in behaviour that is seen to be antisocial.

Vulnerable people in the community have the same rights and responsibilities as any member of the public to:

- Be in public places, but at the same time respecting the right of local community members to live in a safe and peaceful environment; and
- Participate in public activities or events.

If a member of the public or business is concerned about a person experiencing homelessness within the Kwinana Area they can contact the St Parts Assertive Community Outreach team.

#### A response or intervention is appropriate if:


- The person requests assistance, or the person is distressed or in need of
- The person's behaviour is threatening the safety of the individual or the safety and security of people around them;
- The person's behaviour has resulted in damage to property or the environment such as an accumulation of litter or items scattered in the
- The person is sheltering in circumstances that places their own or others health and safety at risk (for example, staying in derelict buildings and high risk areas without the consent of the owner, ie squatting); or
- The person is a young person who appears to be under the age of 18 years old who may be at risk of significant harm.

In these circumstances call local police on 13 14 44
