## Fence Information Sheet

A front fence can include a wall, screen, or the like abutting a street boundary, or located in the front setback area.

Front fences within the primary street setback less than 1.2 m do not require Council Approval

Front fences over 1.2 m in height require Council approvals and must be visually permeable from 1.2 m to 1.8 m . There are also other requirements if located within 1.5 m of a driveway.

Visually Permeable means:-
A Wall, gate, door or fence that the vertical surface has:

- Continuous vertical or horizontal gaps of 50 mm or greater width occupying not less than one third of the total surface area; or
- Continuous vertical or horizontal gaps less than 50 mm in width, occupying at least one half of the total surface area in aggregate; or
- A surface offering equal or lesser obstruction to view;

## Truncation Areas

Areas near a driveway within 1.5 m of where the driveway meets the front boundary are designated as the Truncation Area as per
the Residential Design Codes. These Truncation Areas ensure safety by providing unobstructed sight lines at vehicle access points.

Truncation areas shall not have Within them:


- Solid portions of wall higher than 750 mm and
- More than one pier equal to or greater than 350 mm by 350 mm
