We say we run a **program**.

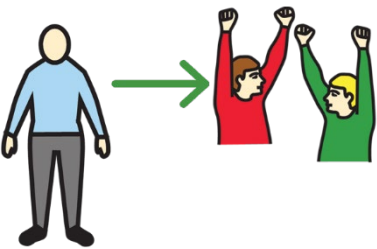


You may find it hard to go to some places.

Or you may care for a person with disability.

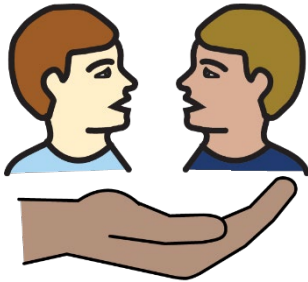


We want you to be able to go to our programs.

We want you to feel safe at our program.

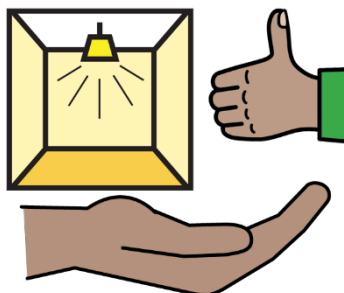


Tell us what you need to feel safe.

or

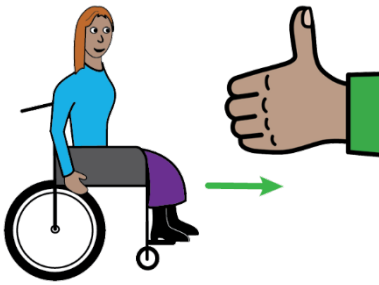
- set up the room in a way that is good for you.

You can use your own help

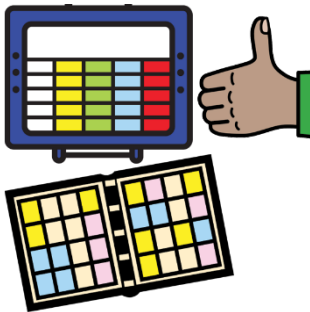


You may use a **mobility aid**.

Use them at our program.

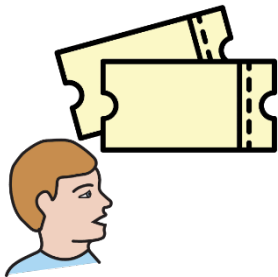


You may want a person with you. Like

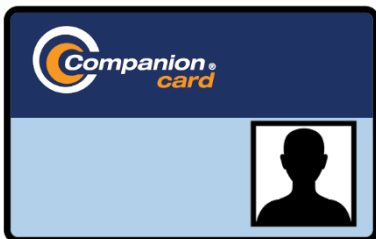
- your carer

When you buy tickets to a program



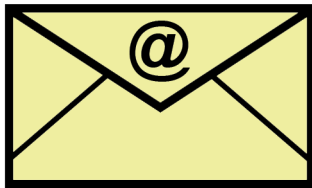
- you can use your **Companion Card**.

Ask us how to use your Companion Card to buy a ticket.



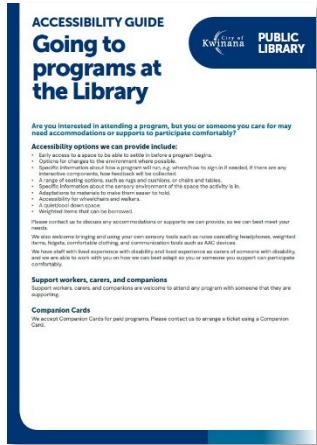
