Policy:

1. Cultural diversity and local identity

The City of Kwinana believes that our community is a place where cultural diversity is acknowledged and celebrated, where people get involved at many levels with cultural and arts activities, and where people have a strong sense of local identity.

2. Cultural heritage and a sense of place

The City of Kwinana recognises that our unique heritage is strongly valued, and is the basis on which the current community builds a sense of place. All efforts are taken to record, preserve and share Kwinana's history and cultural heritage.

3. Culture and the local economy

The City of Kwinana will stimulate cultural and economic growth in Kwinana by maximising opportunities for cultural tourism and cultural enterprise development.

4. Culture and the natural environment

The City of Kwinana will actively protect the natural assets of Kwinana. We recognise that Kwinana has a natural beauty and will ensure that the reserved bush land is maintained so that future generations can enjoy its tranquillity.

5. Cultural activity and the built environment

The City of Kwinana will build environments (social, natural, built and economic) to bring residents together in a way that fosters community participation and connectedness that are visually appealing, pleasant to be in, and engender a sense of community ownership and pride.
