Referral of Proposals to Adjoining Local Authorities

To improve communication and co-operation between adjoining Local Authorities.

To provide the opportunity for adjoining Local Authorities to comment on Planning proposals which are likely to affect land within the adjoining Local Authority.

Legal Authority:	Local Government Act Section 2.7 – The Role of Council Town Planning and Development Act 1928 (as amended), Town Planning Scheme No 2.

Policy:

That details of any development application, subdivision or rezoning likely to affect an adjoining Local Authority be referred to that Council for comment.

As a minimum any Development Application involving a use listed as SA under the operative Town Planning Scheme or Rezoning on land having a common boundary with an adjoining Local Authority should be referred to that Local Authority for comment.
