Use of Recquatic Facilities Emergency Services Personnel

To recognise the efforts made by emergency services personnel, volunteers and similar organisations who provide an essential service to the community. Further to promote healthy lifestyles amongst to these volunteers and to encourage the utilisation of the City’s Recquatic facility

Policy:

1. That Emergency Services personnel be granted free use of the Recreation Centre (Recquatic Centre) on the basis that the usage will not result generally in any meaningful additional cost being incurred by the City of Kwinana.

The areas provided free of charge within this policy include:

- (a) Aquatic Centre
- (b) Gymnasium, including assessment and programme when required
- (c) Special programs organised by the Centre at the discretion of the Centre Manager

NOTE: This policy does not apply to families or people accompanying any person provided for in accordance with this policy.

2. The City shall record the cost of all Emergency Services personnel using the Recquatic facilities by an internal book entry charging the appropriate cost centre and crediting the Recquatic Centre’s income accounts.
3. For the purposes of this policy, the following people will be deemed to be Emergency Services Personnel:
 - Fire Brigade members
 - Volunteer Fire Brigade members

- Police Officers
- Ambulance Officers
- Transit Officers

The above officers need to confirm that a reasonable portion of their time is allocated to the Kwinana district, or to assisting Kwinana residents outside of the Kwinana area.
