

Local native species planting recommendations

Homestead Ridge

All species listed are naturally occurring in the bushlands within Homestead Ridge. The City of Kwinana uses this species list as a guide for our annual revegetation program solely within Homestead Ridge.

To ensure a high survival rate, it is recommended to plant after the first rains in May/June and to water at least once a week throughout the first two summers. After this, the plants should take root and become self-sufficient. A native plant fertiliser and/or soil conditioner is recommended. Staking and bagging your plants will protect them from trampling and grazing animals.

Trees (5 – 10m)*

<i>Allocasuarina fraseriana</i> (Sheoak)	5-15m high	Brown flowers, May to October
<i>Banksia attenuata</i> (Slender Banksia)	0.4-10m high	Yellow flowers, October to December or January to February
<i>Banksia grandis</i> (Bull Banksia)	1.5-10m high	Yellow-green flowers, September to December or January
<i>Banksia menziesii</i> (Firewood Banksia)	1.3-7m high	Pink/red/yellow flowers, February to October
<i>Corymbia calophylla</i> (Marri)	To 40m	Pink/white flowers, December or January to May
<i>Eucalyptus gomphocephala</i> (Tuart)	10-40m high	White flowers, January to April

<i>Eucalyptus marginata</i> (Jarrah)	To 40m high	White-cream/pink flowers, June to December or January
<i>Xylomelum occidentale</i> (Woody Pear)	2-8m high	Cream-white flowers, December or January to February

**Not recommended to be planted close to the house or near powerlines.*

Shrubs (2 - 5m)

<i>Acacia pulchella</i> (Prickly Moses)	0.3-3m high	Yellow flowers, May to December
<i>Acacia rostellifera</i> (Summer-scented Wattle)	1-6m high	Yellow flowers, July to October or December
<i>Acacia saligna</i> (Orange Wattle)	1.5-6m high	Yellow flowers, July to November
<i>Adenanthos cygnorum</i> (Common Woolybush)	To 4m high	White-cream-pink-green flowers, July to December or January
<i>Banksia sessilis</i> (Parrot Bush)	0.5-5m high	Cream-yellow flowers, April to November
<i>Exocarpos sparteus</i> (Broom Ballart)	1-4m high	Yellow/yellow-green/white flowers, February to October
<i>Hakea prostrata</i> (Harsh Hakea)	1-3m high	White-cream flowers, July to October

<i>Jacksonia furcellata</i> (Grey Stinkwood)	0.4-4m high	Yellow and orange/red flowers, October to December or January
<i>Jacksonia sternbergiana</i> (Stinkwood)	1.5-5m high	Yellow-orange flowers, January to December
<i>Kunzea glabrescens</i> (Spearwood)	1.5-4m high	Yellow flowers, October to November
<i>Xanthorrhoea preissii</i> (Grass tree)	Up to 5m high	White-cream flowers, June or August to December

Shrubs (<2m)

<i>Bossiaea eriocarpa</i> (Common Brown Pea)	0.2-1m high	Yellow and brown/red flowers, July to November
<i>Calothamnus quadrifidus</i> (One-sided Bottlebrush)	0.9-2m high	Red/white-yellow flowers, June to December
<i>Calytrix angulata</i> (Yellow Starflower)	0.2-1m high	Yellow-cream flowers, August to December
<i>Calytrix fraseri</i> (Pink Summer Calytrix)	0.2-1m high	Pink/pink and purple and yellow flower, November to December or January to August
<i>Daviesia divaricata</i> (Marno)	0.3-3m high	Yellow/orange/red/ purple/brown, June to November
<i>Gompholobium tomentosum</i> (Hairy Yellow Pea)	0.3-1m high	Yellow flowers, July to December or January

<i>Hemiandra pungens</i> (Snakebush)	0.05-1m high	White/blue-purple/pink flowers, January to December
<i>Hibbertia hypericoides</i> (Yellow Buttercups)	0.2-1m high	Yellow flowers, April to December
<i>Hibbertia subvaginata</i>	0.15-1.2m high	Yellow flowers, July to December
<i>Hovea trisperma</i> (Common Hovea)	0.1-0.7m high	Purple-Blue flowers, May to November
<i>Hypocalymma robustum</i> (Swan River Myrtle)	0.4-1m high	Pink/pink-red flowers, June to November
<i>Laxmannia squarrosa</i> (Paper Lily)	0.03-0.1m high	White flowers, September to November
<i>Lysiandra calycina</i> (False Boronia)	0.2-1.2m high	White-crem/pink flowers, June to December or January
<i>Macrozamia riedlei</i> (Zamia palm)	0.5-3m high	Flowers September to October
<i>Petrophile linearis</i> (Pixie Mops)	0.2-1m high	Pink and white flowers, August to December
<i>Philotheca spicata</i> (Pepper and Salt)	0.2-0.6m high	Pink-purple-blue/white flowers, June to November
<i>Pimelea rosea</i> (Rose Banjine)	0.3-1m high	Pink/red-purple, July to December
<i>Scholtzia involucrata</i> (Spiked Scholtzia)	0.2-1.5m high	Pink-white flowers, January to May or August to September or November to December
<i>Stirlingia latifolia</i> (Blueboy)	0.2-1.5m high	Yellow/yellow-brown/red-brown flowers, August to October
<i>Xanthorrhoea brunonis</i>	To 1.5m high	White-cream flowers, October to December

Climbers

Hardenbergia comptoniana (Native Wisteria)	Climbing	Blue-purple/white flowers, July to October
Kennedia prostrata (Running Postman)	Twining Shrub	Red flowers, April to November

Perennial Herbs

Anigozanthos manglesii (Kangaroo Paw)	0.2-1.1m high	Green and red flowers, August to November
Arnocrinum preissii	0.15-0.5m high	Purple flowers, October to December or January to February
Burchardia congesta (Milkmaids)	To 0.8m high	White flowers, July to November
Caesia micrantha (Pale Grass-Lily)	0.15-0.6m high	White/blue/purple flowers, September to November
Chamaescilla corymbosa (Blue Squill)	0.05-0.4m high	Blue flowers, July to December
Conostylis aculeata (Prickly Conostylis)	0.06-0.5m high	Yellow flowers, August to November
Desmocladus flexuosus	0.2-1.5m high	Brown/white flowers, July to October

Dianella revoluta (Blueberry Lily)	0.3-1.5m high	Blue-purple-violet flowers, August to December or January or April.
Lepidosperma squamatatum	0.15-1m high	Brown flowers, March to November
Lomandra caespitosa (Tufted Mat Rush)	0.1-0.4m high	Yellow/cream flowers, July to October
Patersonia occidentalis (Purple Flag)	1m high	Purple flowers, August to December
Phlebocarya ciliata	0.2-0.6m high	White flowers, September to November
Ptilotus polystachyus (Prince of Wales Feather)	0.15-1.5m high	Green-white-yellow-brown, April to November or January
