Carol was elected as a Councillor to the (then) Town of Kwinana in May 1997. She served as Deputy from 2005-2006 before being elected as the first woman Mayor to the Town in May 2006, a position she has held to this date. Carol's term as Councillor expires in October 2017.

Carol holds a law degree and is also a graduate of the Australian Institute of Company Directors.

Amongst Carol's numerous council commitments, she is a member of the South Metropolitan Zone of Councils and a WA Local Government Association State Council delegate and a member of its Governance Policy team and a member of the Local Government House Trust.

Carol is the Metropolitan Commissioner for the WA Grants Commission and a recent past member of the Metropolitan Redevelopment Authority (MRA).

Carol is a board member of the Moorditj Koort Aboriginal Corporation, Gilmore College Independent School board, Murdoch University School of Law Advisory Board, Kwinana Early Years' Service (KEYS) and Chairperson of the Kwinana Citizens Advice Bureau.

Carol has a keen interest in improving the local image of Kwinana and economic development and planning of the Kwinana and South metropolitan region.
